Last Call For Zimbabwe



We are finalizing our travel plans for Zimbabwe but we have room for you to be on this team. This is FBNO's second trip with ReClaimed Project and our first to Zimbabwe. We are partnering with Allison and Brett Barnhill in their work in Gweru during the first week of January. I pray that you will consider joining this team. ReClaimed Project partners with local churches to reach orphans and widows with the love of Christ focusing on evangelism, education, and economic development.

Brett and Allison are starting their new work in Zimbabwe by assisting widows with sustainable agriculture. Each widow that they partner with will have a plot of land to grow corn. They are guiding the women through this process and working with them through each stage. They hope that this method will give the widows some independence and a dependable source of nutrition.

The widows who they partner with also want to give back, so they are leading the way on an orphan care ministry. This is a picture of what makes ReClaimed Project such a valuable ministry partner. The ministry which they offer to one group is then multiplied to care for others. They are modeling our Core Value that "We Disciple in Motion." I hope that you will consider coming with us to join them in their work, support them, encourage them, and learn from them.
