#### My Father

God is sometimes referred to in the Bible as "the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 15:6; 2 Corinthians 1:3).

If I know the son, I feel like I have at least some understanding about the father. "So you are Steven's dad," I might say as I shake his hand for the first time. I am looking at this man, picking up on physical similarities with his son. If I have respect and admiration for Steven, then I am looking at his father with some of that in my mind. I suspect that I am meeting a good man if his son is a good friend.

I am assuming a lot, of course. And some of it may not work out to be true. But if this man raised his son, then some of the personality traits and ways of behaving are likely to have been learned from his father. They are often passed down, too, just like physical traits.

When you learn that the God who made it all is also the Father of our Lord Jesus that should be a comfort to you. The apple doesn't fall very far from the tree, the saying goes, for good or ill. If the son has proved to be an outstanding person, his father may prove to be the same.

If God is truly our Father in Heaven, as Jesus taught us to call him, then long association with him should change our personality and character. With God as our Father, we should be in the process of becoming more loving and kind, wise and faithful. Our Father would be passing on these traits to us, his children.

I look in the mirror, now, and I see my Dad staring back at me. Maybe in the process of time and travel, the image of the Father in heaven will take shape in my spiritual reflection. A father can always hope.
