The Body of Christ

I was reminded again this past Sunday about how awesome the body of Christ truly is! I was sitting with my friends that I invited to church for our *Invite Your One* emphasis when I began to see a few people quickly rush out the back doors of the worship center. I figured I would see what was going on, but when I arrived in the lobby our children's minister, Faye Scott informed me that my son, Beckett had tripped and hit his head on the corner of a door in the preschool area.

I figured it was just a minor bump or bruise, but when I arrived outside the classroom where he was crying I saw blood everywhere. He had cut his head from the top of his forehead to the bottom. As I held his little hands while he cried, there was a church member holding him from behind just as quiet and calm as she could be. There was also a doctor working worship care in one of the rooms across the hall, and he quickly responded and began cleaning up the blood and wrapping Beckett's head to stop the bleeding. There was also a nurse that arrived a few minutes later to assist the doctor and make sure my son was taken care of in the best way possible. The doctor stayed in touch with me throughout the day—even offering to call the hospital to make sure that Beckett got to see the doctor quickly. Later on that afternoon, some other church members came by and brought Beckett some toy cars, another couple brought him cookies, and yet another couple brought him a foam sword. That's three couples who took time out of their day to check on our son!

God brings all of us together in his church to use our gifts to bring him glory. No one was brought to faith in Christ through this experience, but I know that this experience in Beckett's life can be used down the road to share with others how much the church loved and cared for him. That brings God glory.
