

Each summer churches across our country invest thousands of dollars and hundreds of hours of manpower in something called Vacation Bible School (VBS). Why? VBS is traditionally the most evangelistic outreach effort of the local church. In that week, hundreds of children and their families walk through the doors of a church they might otherwise never enter.



Yesterday morning FBNO hosted the funeral for CJ Davis, a 17-year-old boy who was shot and killed last week. Some

of you may remember CJ as he faithfully attended FBNO for a couple of years as part of the Bunny Friends ministry. Many of you invested in his life in that time. In his short time at FBNO, CJ heard the gospel shared many times. He learned stories from the Bible and he learned that people in a church that he would probably never otherwise be a part of loved him and cared about his physical, emotional, and spiritual needs. My initial reaction when I learned of his death was to thank God that we had had the opportunity to share the message of salvation with him.

Children like CJ are the reason we host VBS and CAC. Their families may never tithe one dime, serve on a committee nor teach a Bible study. But we have the incredible privilege to intentionally share the gospel with these families and provide an opportunity for them to accept Christ. How can you be a part of this kingdom work?
