Training in Generosity

"All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

Review the story of the woman who anointed Jesus' feet with perfume—be equipped by it. Ask God to speak to you through his Word about responding generously to his love for you: 1) what's right? (his teaching), and 2) what's wrong? (his reproof). Ask him 3) how do I get right? (his correction), and 4) how do I stay right? (his training in righteousness).

Monday, September 17 | Read Luke 7:36-38

The Woman, a sinner, weeps over her sin and pours out her gratitude. Ask God to search your heart—and then grieve with the Holy Spirit over your own sin. Thank him for his forgiveness and for new life.

Tuesday, September 18 | Read Luke 7:39

The Pharisee sits in silent judgment, doubting Jesus because he let the woman thank him. Ask God to show you if you are silently condemning anyone. Thank him for cleansing your heart and mind.

Wednesday, September 19 | Read Luke 7:40-43

The Debtors are Jesus' example to teach love to the one who forgives their debts. Make a list today of all that Jesus has given you. Ask him to enlarge your heart to love him proportionately in return.

Thursday, September 20 | Read Luke 7:44-47

The Pharisee invited Jesus in, but then did nothing to show love for him. Ask God to show you if you are stopping short of loving him fully. Ask him to teach you what generous love is and train you to live it.

Friday, September 21 | Read Luke 7:48-50

The Woman went away in peace. Gratitude comes up a lot in the Bible as a way of replacing anxiety with peace. Ask God for your needs and at the same time thank him for his provision. His peace will guard your heart.
