Missions in Zimbabwe

This summer when the team from First Baptist New Orleans was serving in Zimbabwe, we saw God move mightily. The team helped us host a discipleship training for a fellowship of churches in an area called Domboshavo.



One of the pastors in attendance was involved in prison ministry, and looking for more laborers to help him share the gospel in prisons around Zimbabwe. During a testimony time, a man stood up and enthusiastically said, "I am so thankful for this discipleship training. I have been in prison for the past four years and was released earlier this week. My sentence was cut short, and I know it's only because God wants me to go back and continue reaching the lost in the prison for Jesus. I turned myself in for money laundering because Jesus convicted me of my sin. I felt so free once I stopped hiding my crimes and came forward with the truth. During my time in prison I shared the gospel and asked inmates to help me collect donations for those living on death row. Those living on death row are not given soap or blankets. I would walk around with a bucket sharing the gospel, and many inmates donated pieces of their own soap for those on death row. I felt such joy doing what God called me to do, and living in the light. I had a good job before I turned myself in. Now I have no job, but I do have a purpose. I am ready to reach the lost in the prisons of Zimbabwe." He was quickly connected with our pastor friend who was already sharing the gospel in prisons around Zimbabwe.



We are so thankful for the team's willingness to disciple men like this. Long after our teams return to the states, our African partners carry what they learned during the training all over the country. It's truly an eternal investment. We are so thankful for FBNO, their commitment to the gospel in America—and in the uttermost parts of the world!
