I love it when one of our church family members grabs my arms and says, "Hey, hold up a minute, I want to tell you something!" Usually it means that I'm going to hear an encouraging word about how God is at work in the life of our church! I thought you might be encouraged to hear some of my hold-up-a-minute conversations from this past week.

On Saturday, one of our small group leaders pulled me aside as I was leaving a birthday party. "Before you dash away, can I tell you how proud I am of my class?" Of course! She told me that twelve of her class members have committed to reading through the Bible this year—many of them for the first time. They're going to hold each other accountable. That's what the church is supposed to look like, right?

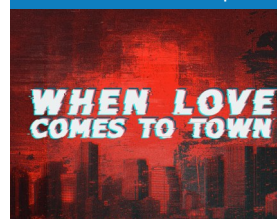
On Sunday, I ran into Slade Simons on the way to his small group. Slade is chairman of the pastor search committee, and he had stopped to thank another small group class for their prayers and words of encouragement. He told me that he feels good about how the search is going. They're moving at a good pace with the recommendations they've received so far—working through them steadily and making very good progress. Keep praying for this committee. They have a big job, and they're making sacrifices to do it. That's the church, isn't it?

On Monday, I visited Barbara LaRose. She's been in the hospital since before Thanksgiving. Her eyes shine with a testimony to God's healing power, because she's a living miracle. I was about to leave when Barbara's husband, Ken, asked me to hold up a minute. He shared that their small group has faithfully ministered to them during their crisis. "They're not just a class," he said. "They're family." He and I agreed, that's what the church is supposed to look like.

How about this week, let's all seek to be the church? Take someone's arm and ask them to hold up a minute. Tell them what God is doing in your life. Ask them what he's up to in theirs. Pray for each other. Encourage each other. That's what the church is supposed to look like.
