STUDENT GUIDELINES

- Students are expected to exhibit behavior over the weekend that is respectful to people and property.
- You are a guest in the home of your host family. Be responsive to request and suggestions. If you break something in the host home you will be responsible for paying for the damages.
- You will need to participate in all aspects of Disciple Now Weekend, including meals, recreation, and service projects where applicable (schedule provided on first night of DNOW).
- You will not be allowed to leave the home of your host family unless you have arranged this with Trey and your Bible Study Leader in advance. **You will need to fill out a “Time Away Card” that is signed by your parents.** The TAC can be picked up from Trey.
- Do not bring MP3 players, portable DVD players, video games, game systems, or other electronic devices.
- “Pranking” supplies are not permitted.
- Alcohol, drugs, fireworks, and weapons are prohibited, of course.
- Cell phones are allowed to remain with students, but are expected to be put away during worship, bible study, and when performing service projects. Bible study leaders have full authority to take cell phones if they feel privilege is being abused, or is causing a distraction for other students.
- You will be assigned to a host home and Bible study leaders on Friday night. There will be no switching homes or leaders.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What in the world is DNOW?

“DNow” stands for Disciple Now. So, a DNOW Weekend is a Disciple Now Weekend. In its simplest form, a Disciple Now Weekend is a weekend retreat for a youth group. This year, churches from all across the New Orleans Metro Area will participate in this exciting weekend hosted at FBNO!! We will have one Friday night worship time and two on Saturday, with some breakout groups, host homes, and a lot of fun in between!!

So is a DNOW Weekend the same as any other retreat?

In some ways, “yes.” But it’s so much more than that! Whereas some retreat weekends are more about getting away and hanging out (which is NOT a bad thing), DNOW Weekends put a high premium on discipleship. There are Large Group sessions where a speaker can move the weekend’s theme along from a big-picture perspective. And there are intentional Small Group times that take place in host homes where students go deeper with their individual small group leaders. It’s a focused time of spiritual growth and application.

What are “host homes”?

“Host Homes” are a key feature of DNow Weekends. A host home is where a family in the church agrees to host a Small Group for the weekend. Some youth ministries will bring back former students to lead a Small Group, or use the weekend as an opportunity to plug-in other adult volunteers.
